We are delighted to have you staying with us during the Holy Month of Ramadan. During this month, all Muslims observe the fast of Ramadan where no food or drink is allowed to pass through their lips during daylight hours. Even smoking is forbidden. The fast is then broken at sunset, when friends and families gather together to enjoy a light breakfast, called 'Iftar'.

Although non-Muslims are not expected to fast, we ask that respect is shown by refraining from smoking, eating or drinking in public areas, both in the hotel and while out and about in Dubai, between sunrise and sunset.

Breaking of fast is best celebrated across the Arab World by gathering the family and sharing the food served with the dates and water as a healthy start. We have arranged dates and Arabic coffee to share with you during Iftar time at the Arabic Lounge located in the hotel lobby.

For your comfort we have designated areas, which will be open for food and beverage throughout the day, as follows:
