

10 'must-do' things in JORDAN this summer

1. Visit **Rainbow Street** and enjoy the many coffee shops, restaurants and many interesting shops (also Jordan River Foundation);
2. Want an out-of-this-world experience? Walk **Petra by Night** : Monday, Wednesday and Thursday evenings from 8.30 – 10pm; (don't forget to walk or ride a camel in **Petra** by day)
3. Feel like swimming in the lowest point of Earth? Float in the **Dead Sea** – it's magnificent and quite bizarre experience;
4. Go to the **Citadel** to see the most beautiful panoramic view of Amman and the largest flag in Jordan, also the site of the ruins of the **Jabal al-Qala'a (Umayyad Palace)**;
5. Visit **Souk Jara** on Rainbow Street on Fridays 10am – 10pm for a wide variety of good deals, handicrafts, antiques and homemade items. Food, beverages and shisha!
6. Take a walk in **downtown Amman** = great restaurants (Al Quds and Hashem) and shopping in a historic setting;
7. Go wild! Forget all your troubles and overnight in a Bedouin camp in **Wadi Rum** for the most awesome sunset, dinner and sleeping-under-the-stars experience!
8. Want to see the most unique car and motorcycle collection in the world? Visit the **Royal Automobile Museum** (the late King Hussein's collection) (every day except Tuesday from 10am – 7pm);
9. Feel like drinking coffee, eating and shopping in one loooooooooooooong street, then visit **Al-Wakalat Street** in Sweifieh;
10. For "an experience beyond your imagination" visit **Al-Pasha Turkish Bath** (near 1st circle) open daily from 10am – 4pm.
